HEALTH AND SAFETY

We understand that customers may wish to visit their new home whilst it is being built and we will endeavour to accommodate any requests to do so. However, access to your new home is subject to Health and Safety Legislation, and we are committed to ensuring the safety of our customers at all times.

Please read the safety information below carefully:

- Any visits to your home during construction will be pre-arranged with our sales team and you will always be accompanied on site. Please do not enter the site unless you are accompanied by one of our representatives. Unauthorised visitors will be asked to leave the site immediately.
- Children under the age of 16 are not permitted to enter the construction areas at any time and our staff will not be able to take any responsibility for children anywhere on the site or our premises. Children are welcome to visit the show home or sales office but they must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- Pets are not allowed on the construction site at any time.
- Please only park on-site in the designated customer car park, where provided. Some sites do not have on-site parking capacity during construction and you will therefore need to park your car off-site. Our sales team will be able to advise on nearby parking availability.
- You will be made aware of the site safety requirements and provided with appropriate protective clothing (safety helmet, footwear, high visibility waistcoat, etc.). You must wear this protective clothing at all times during your visit.
- You must follow the direction and safety signage displayed on-site.
- Do not enter any fenced off areas or anywhere identified as unsafe by a member of our team.
- Ladders, scaffolding and material stacks must not be climbed.
- Stay with the person guiding you at all times. Do not stray out of sight or earshot of your guide, and walk only in the areas directed.
- Construction vehicles and other equipment may be in operation while you are on-site. Please be aware of how close you are to them at all times and also the fact that the driver/operator may not be able to see you.
- Hazardous substances may be in use. Do not enter any areas where application work is in progress.

On the day you move into your new home, construction work may still be in progress in other areas of the development. In these circumstances, safe access to your home will be maintained and the ongoing works will be fenced off.

Access to the continuing work by people and vehicles may still be needed and we will seek to limit both the duration and extent of any inconvenience, but please keep the safety of yourself, your family and your pets in mind while the work continues.
